

OUTDOOR SPACE USAGE

Capital Planning & Space Management (CPSM) is responsible for scheduling campus space for a variety of campus activities, including events sponsored by student organizations and campus departments. Classrooms, conference rooms, atriums and outdoor space can be reserved through the GTEvents Reservation Website.

Outdoor space on the Georgia Tech campus includes selected lawns, walkways, amphitheaters, sidewalks, courtyards, plazas, and parking decks. These areas can be scheduled by chartered student organizations and GT departments. They can be reserved through the GT Events Reservation Website. Groups that reserve outdoor space for their events are responsible for cleaning up the area at the close of the event. All displays, tables and exhibits must be removed from the area once the event has ended. Trash cans and recycle bins can be obtained from the Facilities Department. In addition, recycling is required for all outdoor events. To obtain free recycling containers contact the GT Recycling Office.
