

VISITOR PARKING

To accommodate institute visitors, there are parking zones and meters situated across campus for visitors' use. Visitor parking closest to the Student Center is located in the following areas:

- **Area 2: Student Center**
- **Area 3. Campus Recreation Center/Student Center**

These lots are charged for hourly use, with a daily maximum of \$20.00.

PARKING METERS

There are a limited number of parking meters near the Student Center. Parking meters offer a short term parking solution. Meters are enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week unless otherwise posted. Malfunctioning or broken meters flashing "failed" are considered no parking zones. Parking permits are not valid at metered spaces. Vehicles parked at broken or malfunctioning meters will be cited accordingly. Call 404.385.7275 to report failed meters.

EVENINGS & WEEKENDS

Monday-Friday between the hours of 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. and all day on Saturday and Sunday, Area 2 visitor parking offers a flat rate of \$5.00.

SPECIAL EVENT PARKING

150 Vehicles or Less

Discounted parking vouchers may be purchased for Area 2 and Area 3 during *peak and non-peak times*. Vouchers are \$8.00 per car and must be requested ten (10) business days prior to your event. Unused vouchers are non-refundable.

150 or More Vehicles

Large event parking requires special attention. Parking arrangements can be made to accommodate large events expecting 150 or more vehicles. Large events occurring in the Student Center during non-peak times have the option of utilizing the W02 Parking Garage. Events taking place during peak times will be addressed on a case-by-case basis.

The W02 Parking Garage is based on availability and has two pricing options:

1. **Client Rents Garage for Event Attendees:** The client may purchase the W02 Garage for a flat fee starting at \$500.00, which includes the raising of the gates and an attendant.
2. **Guest(s) Pay to Park in Reserved Parking Garage:** Guests park in the W02 Garage and pay \$7.00 per vehicle upon entry or exit. This option includes an attendant for the duration of the event.

Peak Times: Fall & Spring Semesters, Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

Non-Peak Times: Winter & Summer Breaks; Institute Holidays; Monday-Friday, after 5 p.m.; Weekends

A Student Center Event Coordinator will assist in making arrangements with Parking & Transportation Services to accommodate your event parking needs.
